Eligibility Criteria

1.0 Inclusion Criteria

- 1.1 Adults aged 18 years or older with one of the following newly diagnosed cancers: breast cancer, colorectal cancer, melanoma, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, or non-small cell lung cancer.
- Planned treatment with systemic chemotherapy (single or multi-agent, includes targeted therapy) and/or immune checkpoint inhibitor therapy (targeting PD-1, PD-L1 or CTLA-4). If unable to engage participant before treatment starts, enrollment is allowed up to the start of Cycle 2 treatment.
- 1.3 Participants must be able to comprehend English or Spanish (for survey completion).
- 1.4 Participant must have a working email address and be willing to complete surveys online. This can be completed at home, in the clinic or other location.
- 1.5 Completion of the confidential Self-reported Screening Survey and receipt of a screening result eligible for enrollment.

2.0 Exclusion Criteria

- 2.1 Currently enrolled in an interventional supportive treatment trial to manage cancer symptoms.
- 2.2 Participants with known pregnancy
